Footnotes

ATTEMPTRESS, well placed from the start while following the leaders four wide, advanced from that position to wrest command in the upper stretch and was under stout left-handed encouragement in the drive. SNAPPY, never far back while racing in behind rivals until near the stretch, came out four wide for the drive, finished willingly but was second best. MOONLIGHT SONATA settled in behind rivals, raced within easy striking distance, swung out five wide for the stretch run and improved position late while not a serious threat. TENDER TRAP, outsprinted early, moved five wide into the stretch to reach contention but lacked a serious late response. FAST COOKIE, never far back while five wide, lacked a closing response. SPECIALITY, within striking distance while four wide between foes on the turn, came out six wide for the drive but failed to rally. IFUFEELFROGGYLEAP contested the pace from early on while outside of SAFARA, took over on the turn, made the pace into the stretch and faltered. SAFARA gained a slim lead inside early while dueling with IFUFEELFROGGYLEAP, held on well until the stretch and tired. MISSINTENSE difficult to load into the gate, broke slowly and awkwardly, then never was close. CANDY CANE C C moved inside early and was outrun.
