Footnotes

COPPER BELLE, outsprinted early and six wide most of the way, advanced steadily from that position into the stretch, collared the leaders at the furlong grounds and edged clear late under pressure. CALL FOR HONOR, well placed from the beginning, tracked the leaders three or four wide, moved to a slight lead nearing the eighth pole, then couldn't handle COPPER BELLE late. SPEED TO BURN, within easy striking distance while following the leaders four or five wide, loomed prominently for the final furlong and wasn't good enough. PRADO STRUTTER, outrun for a half, came out nine or 10 wide for the drive and offered a mild, steady gain. MISS N TEXAS, in contention while in behind foes three wide to the lane, eased out between horses four or five wide for the drive and lacked a late response. INSIDE RUN, within striking distance inside throughout, failed to rally. SUMMER HEAT, well placed three or four wide to the stretch, flattened out in the drive. BO'S SISTER failed to rally. ANGIE'S CAT failed to reach contention. HIGH DIVA ducked out at the start, hit the side of the gate and never was close. ALL OF ME unseated the rider behind the gate prior to being loaded and ran off up the chute. She was captured and returned to the gate. During the running, ALL OF ME broke in front, held a slight edge while dueling outside of OPEN STORY to the stretch, held on until the final furlong and faltered. OPEN STORY battled for the lead inside of ALL OF ME until the stretch and tired.
