Footnotes

HOLD A MOONBEAM drifted out at the start, was never far back, raced in behind the leaders, eased out four wide nearing the stretch, drifted in for a stride when appearing clear of rivals at the three-sixteenths pole, then was ridden hard to prevail. ERHU gained a clear lead early while edging inward, made the pace into the stretch, drifted in and out at the three-sixteenths pole, then couldn't contain the winner late. AIMER ducked in at the start on WIN MY HEART, was unhurried, raced in behind rivals, came out to follow the winner five wide into the lane and failed to gain in the late stages. VICTORY SPIRIT, unhurried early, raced inside into the stretch, eased out four or five wide in the final furlong but was empty late. WHAT TO WEAR eased out early to track front-running ERHU four wide, raced forwardly until the stretch and tired. SHINING VICTORY bobbled early, recovered to gain a contending position, raced four or five wide to the stretch and flattened out. MAZEL TOV came out at the start on WIN MY HEART, then failed to menace. PRESENT tired on the far turn. SIERRA'S ATHENA weakened after a half. WIN MY HEART, bumped from both sides at the star and squeezed back badly, was steadied, never was close and distanced in the lane when not persevered with. A FOUL CLAIM LODGED BY THE TRAINER OF ERHU AGAINST THE WINNER FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN THE UPPER STRETCH WAS DISALLOWED.
