Footnotes

GOLDEN MARLIN, never far back while following the leaders five wide, closed determinedly in the late going to be along in time. MOLTO VITA tracked the dueling leaders early while four wide, took over in the upper stretch, edged clear, then couldn't contain the winner's surge. SOURIS, outrun early, moved near the inside, came out seven or eight wide for the drive and was gaining late. THERE RUNS HATTIE, outprinted early, moved inside, remained near the inside for the drive and offered a mild gain. KEIAI SAKURA, four or five wide for a half, came out eight wide for the stretch run but was empty late. SILENT STREAM went up inside to contest the pace early, gained a slight edge while battling inside of THAT'S OUR TRICKY on the turn, lost the advantage back to that one before going a half and weakened in the drive. THAT'S OUR TRICKY gained a slim lead early while four wide, battled with SILENT STREAM while outside that one, lost the edge to SILENT STREAM briefly entering the turn, regained the edge just before going a half, held on well until the stretch and faltered. SLEWS FINAL ANSWER tired after a half.
