Footnotes

SUTTON'S BAY, never far back while in behind the dueling leaders five wide, lacked room at the five-sixteenths pole, eased out five wide entering the upper stretch, then closed determinedly under pressure to be along in time. UNBRIDLED IDOL, unhurried early and three or four wide, moved four wide when rallying, took over entering the stretch, briefly was clear between calls, then couldn't contain the winner's surge. GOLDEN VICTRESS gained a slim lead early while dueling three or four wide outside of PICK FIVE, held on well until the final quarter and weakened. PICK FIVE contested the pace inside GOLDEN VICTRESS to the stretch and weakened. SPINDERELLA, outrun to the stretch and five wide, came out eight wide for the drive, loomed a solid threat for the last eighth but failed to muster a significant gain thereafter. AMELIA SARATOGA (JPN), up close between horses four or five wide for five furlongs, gradually weakened. PRINCESS FALINA bobbled at the start, gained a forward position between horses five wide, remained in contention to the lane and weakened. DUTCH GIRL, forwardly placed although six wide on the backstretch, remained in contention while continuing off the inside until nearing the final quarter and tired in the drive.
