Footnotes

AIMER settled inside early, raced four wide around the far turn, circled foes seven or eight wide into the stretch and drove clear late. TITIAN TIME tracked the pace in hand four wide, took over just after going six furlongs, opened a clear advantage and had no mishap while unable to repel the winner's surge. MAMA I'M HOME, outrun for a half, and five wide, made a menacing run just inside the winner into the final furlong but could not sustain the needed momentum. COTOPAXI, well placed near the inside throughout, failed to fire. MOUNTAIN MAMBO, within easy striking distance, raced between foes three or four wide and failed to muster a late response. KEYS angled inside soon after the break, raced in behind horses to the stretch, split rivals and improved position in the late going. AUNT DOT DOT, unhurried early, moved inside on the far turn and failed to rally. CAT'S FORTY, within striking distance and between foes to the stretch, flattened out in the drive. BOJANGLE'S CAT forced the pace from early on while outside of SKIP THE STORM, gained a slight advantage nearing the final quarter but faltered in the drive. SKIP THE STORM gained a slight edge early while maneuvering inside, was clear briefly on the backstretch, lost the advantage on the far turn to BOJANGLES CAT and weakened thereafter.
