GALLOPING DOMINO broke sharply, sped clear to set the pace, drifted out through the final furlong and was all out to just last. FIRST PRIZE broke in the air, settled in hand, advanced between horses through the turn, came five wide into the stretch, finished willingly and was gaining with every stride. RANAWAY YANKEE was allowed to settle, responded when roused with three furlongs to run, bid between horses four wide leaving the turn but lacked the needed late response. FOUR ELEVEN was slow early, made a long drive circled five wide, offered a mild bid entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. GOLDEN WATTLE settled saving ground, shifted out entering the stretch and finished with a mild rally. EILIANNE was close up four wide, but weakened between horses leaving the turn and faded. BAHNEY BELL broke slow and was never a factor. SUGAR MAY attended the pace along the inside to the stretch and tired. ABSOLUTE CHARM was close up between horses to the turn and dropped out. MUCHU was through after a half. TOMO NIGHTS was fractious in the gate, was slow into stride, drifted out on the turn, was pulled up nearing the quarter pole and was vanned off.
