VALID CITIZEN settled in hand, closed the gap three wide through the turn, split rivals inside the furlong marker and quickly opened clear. HE AIN'T RIGHT contended off of the inside, advanced between horses on the turn, angled out five wide and loomed large a furlong out but was unable to match strides with

the winner. IT'S GOTTA BE US was close up along the inside, checked hard near the seven-sixteenths pole, shifted out and came again between horses, angled in entering the stretch and continued on well to earn the show. LUCKY SASS was allowed to settle, moved up five wide to make a mild bid but lacked the needed late response. GENTLEMAN JOHN set the pressured pace three wide, but weakened between horses in the final furlong and faded. BLACK CROW disputed the pace four wide to the final furlong and gave way. BLACK PATCH contended between horses, was caught in tight near the seven-sixteenths pole, stayed on fairly well to the stretch and retreated. KRUM KAKE pulled between horses, drifted out through the turn and failed to threaten. CHAFFEE JOHN failed to respond. TEEBERRY showed little. BUDDHA CAN DANCE trailed.
