ROD AND STAFF moved in behind the leaders early, saved ground until nearing the stretch, came out four wide and was hard ridden to prevail. RICHTER SCALE, racing in front bar shoes, broke sharply to gain the lead, edged clear, went along under careful handling, shook off a bid from YAQTHAN (IRE) in the upper stretch but couldn't contain the winner late. YAQTHAN (IRE) went up early to press front-running RICHTER SCALE from the outside, loomed boldly for the drive but failed to respond. TRAIL CITY appeared rank soon after the start and possibly shied while ducking in sharply, nearing struck the inner railing, finally settled on the first turn, saved ground to the stretch, came out five or six wide for the stretch run but couldn't offer the needed response. EL ANGELO failed to menace. CHARMES tired nearing the stretch.
