KATZ ME IF YOU CAN went up soon after the start to vie for the lead from between foes, continued in that manner the remainder and was fully extended to outfinish BURRITO. The latter gained the lead early, held a slight edge while racing four wide on the backstretch while dueling with the winner and EMILY'S ANGEL, held on well until deep stretch but wasn't good enough. BELIEVE, never far back, loomed six wide for the last eighth and finished willingly while unable to make up the difference. CRAWLEYVILLE broke through the gate prior to the start and was alertly snared by the assistant starter and reloaded. During the running, CRAWLEYVILLE saved ground while outrun for a half, ranged up behind rivals for the drive to reach contention, loomed four wide but lacked a late response. EMILY'S ANGEL went up early to force the pace three abreast, battled on about even terms into the upper stretch and weakened. LIL BIT OF COUNTRY, outrun until the stretch, offered a mild gain. PREMIER PEAK, well placed and saving ground inside the dueling leaders into the final furlong, flattened out. TELL IT, outsprinted from the start, raced eight wide into the stretch and failed to respond. EASY ACTION was finished leaving the turn while six or seven wide. DEMITRYST wasn't a serious factor and seven or eight wide in the stretch run.
