Footnotes

NAUGHTY MAMBO, forced in soon after the start, was rated near the inside, lacked room leaving the eighth pole, came out and split foes three wide soon after and was under hand urging to prevail. WILLIAMS DANCER bobbed at the break, raced along the inside under a rating hold for a half, came out five wide for the drive, loomed menacingly but wasn't good enough. SMILIN' KITTEN drifted in at the start forcing the winner inward, gained the lead, raced two or three wide, made the pace into deep stretch and faltered. WILD NOTE tracked the leaders five wide into the final furlong and was empty. MONTREAL'S BEST went up early to press front-running SMILIN' KITTEN from the outside, battled on about even terms into the stretch and was checked when in a bit tight leaving the furlong grounds. ALIAS SPECIAL was outrun.
