Footnotes

KEEP THE FEELING gained a narrow lead early, edged inward, shook off EVERSMILE and THANK THE ACADEMY entering the stretch, kicked clear and was kept to her task. PARADING TOMISUE, reserved early while racing in behind horses, came out seven or eight wide at the quarter-mile ground while advancing, angled in when clear of foes at the eighth pole but wasn't a match for the winner late. THANK THE ACADEMY worked her way in early to track the pace four abreast, battled close up into the lane and flattened out. QUICK ADVICE, within easy striking distance throughout while following the leaders four or five wide, lacked a closing bid. MAREN APPROVED, nicely placed along the inside from early on, remained prominently into the final furlong and came up empty. KEEPING WATCH (IRE), in contention along the inside from the outset, was checked inside at the three-sixteenths pole, moved out six wide soon after but lacked a late account. GRANITA, within striking distance while between foes three or four wide, failed to rally. EVERSMILE went up early to press front-running KEEP THE FEELING four wide, held on well for six furlongs and tired. PAUSE FOR APPLAUSE bobbed at the start, bumped the side of the gate, was outrun early, moved inside on the far turn, worked her way out seven wide when straightened for the drive and never menaced. WHITE OAK, fractious in the gate prior to the start, raced five wide and faded.
