Footnotes

THATSMORELIKEIT, never far back while tracking the pace between foes four or five wide, inched to the front about the sixteenth pole and was hard ridden to hold sway. BOOTS ARE WALKING stumbled at the start, ducked in jolting PENN PACIFIC, forced that one in on COUNT ORANGE, was outsprinted early and closed late while five or six wide. HUNTING HILLBILLY, outrun to the stretch, found his best stride late while between rivals. BRUCE ON THE LOOSE, outrun for three furlongs, circled foes seven or eight wide and was gaining late. SWISSLE STICK gained the lead near the inside, was clear nearing the stretch, held on well into the final furlong and weakened. PENN PACIFIC, slammed at the start by BOOTS ARE WALKING and forced in, made a run from between rivals into the final furlong but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. CHOSEN CHIEF, within striking distance and five or six wide, flattened out at the end. EITHER ORR, up close between foes four wide into the final furlong, angled inside but came up empty. CAYENNE RED raced in

contention to the stretch and tired. HONORING, well placed inside to the stretch, gradually weakened. JIMMY'S BOY, forwardly placed near the inside early, was steadied at the quarter-mile ground and dropped back. COUNT ORANGE, sluggish to start, was checked sharply off horses heels after breaking to lose his action and lost all chance.
