CHANGING WEATHER settled two or three wide, maneuvered out five wide leaving the turn, took over in deep stretch and held off COURT FOLLY at the end. COURT FOLLY bobbled while breaking sluggishly, was outrun for a half, circled horses seven or eight wide and finished with good energy. HE'S GOT GRIT sprinted to the fore, accomplished rapid fractions, was clear for the last eighth but couldn't last. EL NINO forced the pace from early on, chased HE'S GOT GRIT into the final furlong while four wide and weakened. GRAND SURVIVAL settled near the inside, angled five wide into the stretch, loomed a solid threat for the last eighth and came up empty. DEPUTY G, outrun four or five wide to the stretch edged in a bit but never reached serious contention. SKELETON CREW followed the leaders four or five wide in a striking position to the stretch and tired. CHIEF WHAT IT IS broke in the air, rushed up between foes soon after and gave way readily upon going a half.
