Footnotes

MOONSHINER hopped at the break while coming away sluggishly, gained contention four wide upon going a quarter, took over in the upper stretch, kicked clear and continued under strong handling. SULTRY BIDDER settled three wide, swung out six wide for the stretch run and was fully extended to be along for the place. THUNDERBOLT IN MAY settled in behind rivals, continued from the rail into the lane and lacked a late account. DARING DON, outrun four wide to the stretch, maneuvered wider and improved position. ROCK PULPIT sprinted clear two wide, made the pace into the upper stretch and weakened. CLASSICAL RHYTHM, well placed three wide for a half, weakened gradually. LITTLE MONEY swerved out at the start, angled in four wide and was done leaving the turn. THIS RACE WAS HAND TIMED IN 1:17.87.
