SILVER ROCK unhurried for a half, made a five wide run into the stretch and closed fast to win going away. LET'S DO IT outrun for a half, made a solid inside middle moved, angled out for the drive and finished will while following the winner. ALMORADI (IRE) reserved along the inside, advanced along the inside after five furlongs but had no late bid. PATHOKI sprinted clear, set a fast pace but faltered late. AFTER SHOCK closest to the pace off the inside, lacked a rally. RONIN DAX was no threat. ZEB took back and angled in entering the first turn, was forwardly placed and tired. I'LL SHOW THEM unhurried off the inside, moved four wide into the stretch and could not menace.
