SALTY STRIKE settled in hand, pulled to the lead four wide leaving the turn, took over and quickly drew clear. DRAW IT was slow into stride and unhurried early, circled five wide to make a late rally and was up in time to earn the place. FORMAL PLAN opened clear to set the pace, was collared after the opening quarter, disputed the issue through the turn, was no match for the winner entering the stretch, weakened further and was all out to save the show spot. SOCIAL VINDICATION tracked the pace three wide, was caught in tight between horses near the three furlong marker, steadied and flattened thereafter. JAPANESE GARDEN was unhurried, came three wide and finished with a belated gain but failed to threaten. RATOATH SPECIAL stumbled at the start, rushed to the lead along the inside, vied for a half and stopped.
