Footnotes

AT THE PULPIT settled in hand, tucked in to save ground, shifted out and split horses to commence his bid, forged command with a furlong to run and was fully extended to prevail. DREAMS CUT SHORT settled saving ground, angled out seven wide, finished well and was getting to the winner with every stride. SOUL OF THE MOON was unhurried into stride, took closer order through the second turn, swung eight wide inside the three-sixteenths pole and kicked on well to earn the show. WASHINGTON DASH was allowed to settle, drew even six wide entering the stretch but flattened in the drive. Z CAMELOT contended off of the inside, but weakened between horses in the drive and gave way. CHEYENNE PASS tracked the pace three wide, loomed a danger entering the stretch but weakened between rivals in the final furlong. ACT OF WAR (IRE) sent clear to set the pace, widened on the backstretch, controlled the tempo to near the furlong marker but came up empty and gave way readily once headed. AWESOME LIFE settled saving ground, got through entering the stretch but faltered and dropped out. SHAH EN SHAH was always outrun and was distanced through the stretch.
