PARADE OF HOMES bumped at the start, tracked the leader while off the inside, challenged when ready once in the stretch and drew off under steady urging. ZAHARIAS forwardly placed three wide, lodged a mild bid for the place. BONITA MUNECA bore out at the start bothering outer rivals, sprinted clear after being straightened, set the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. NEVER TELL LYNDIA within striking distance four wide, lacked a late bid. BELLAMY'S ROSE bothered at the start, raced within reach while near the rail but failed to respond in the stretch. TART'S KNICKERS bothered at the start, was outrun while off the inside. MAD ABOUT SUE was no factor. SHERRY ANGEL carried out at the start, steadied repeatedly in the run down the backstretch, moved out five wide once in the turn and tired.
