Footnotes

MIDDIE within striking distance off the inside, made a run four wide on the second turn and drew clear late. TWINSPIRED forwardly placed three wide, made a run at the leaders on the second turn and held on gamely. MINISTER COLIN outrun along the inside, angled out for the drive and made a good late gain. READY TO TAUNT reserved three wide, made a good run to the furlong marker but weakened late. MANDURAH set the pace along the inside, held on well to midstretch and tired. LOOKIN AT TIGER outrun early, made a solid run after six furlongs but could not sustain the bid. GUTSY CALL closest to the pace off the inside, held on well to the final furlong and tired. MOTOR CITY within reach inside, gave way. MORE THAN NOBLE unhurried off the rail, swerved out in upper stretch and never reached contention.
