Footnotes

SING OUT BABY, unhurried for a half, moved between foes while advancing on the turn five wide, continued five abreast into the stretch, reached the front nearing the final furlong and edged clear late under intermittent urging. CHEROKEE RAIN moved to the rail early to stalk the leaders, rallied along the rail to reach the front entering the stretch, then couldn't handle the winner late. ROANOKE LADY gained the lead early, made the pace until the final quarter and weakened. SAVANAHA, within striking distance, angled six wide for the last eighth and failed to rally. PLEASANT PURSUIT improved position while saving ground. SAVANA D, well placed from the start, moved with the winner while inside that one four wide nearing the stretch but flattened out when straightened for the drive. DIXIE NIMBLE moved off the inside early to press pacesetting ROANOKE LADY and faded leaving the turn. CHEHAW, five or six wide throughout, wasn't a threat and faded in the drive.
