Footnotes

IDOL GIFT, never far back and saving ground until the stretch, angled out five wide for the drive and was hard ridden to be along in time. STEALTH, well placed while stalking the leaders four or five wide, gained even terms for the lead inside the winner in deep stretch and was outfinished. CIRQUE VIEW went up early to force the pace three abreast, gained a slim lead at the furlong grounds, then failed to sustain the needed momentum. ROENA went up early to vie for the lead from between foes, gained a slight advantage on the turn but weakened in the final furlong. GREENAPPLEGAL, outrun until the stretch, offered a mild gain while five or six wide in the drive. FLATTENED, outrun until the stretch, failed to seriously menace while improving position six wide. PRINCESS T, six or seven wide on the backstretch, failed to menace. TIME CRISIS wasn't a factor. MISS KITTY'S CITY was used up inside contesting the pace the opening half. SARATOGA HONEY, unruly when unseating the rider approaching the gate, raced forwardly for nearly a half and tired.
