Footnotes

RICHTER'S EMBLEM went up early to press front-running SNOGUN three wide, took over from that one leaving the turn, moved clear and was kept to her task to widen. ZIG'S QUIET LADY, outsprinted early, raced in behind rivals, came out six wide leaving the turn, was just off the winner for the last eighth but couldn't offer the needed response as second best. MISS LACY SHEA, bumped soundly at the start, was never far back while in behind rivals, moved four wide into the stretch, loomed a threat for the last eighth but came up empty. DASHING GIRL, near the inside, failed to rally. LIL BIT OF COUNTRY, jolted at the start and forced in on MISS LACY SHEA, was outrun to the stretch and not a serious threat while improving position. SNOGUN ducked in at the break slamming LIL BIT OF COUNTRY, gained the lead while moving near the inside, made the pace for a half and weakened. HIDDEN, well placed five wide early, continued five wide around the turn, tired, and was eight wide in the stretch run. TO THE TEST stalked the pace four wide for three furlongs and weakened thereafter.
