Footnotes

GRAT, outrun for six furlongs, was put to a drive three furlongs out while five wide, came seven wide for the drive and closed determinedly to be along in time. MAKE MY HEART SING, unhurried early, advanced steadily around the far turn four or five wide, moved six wide into the stretch, reached the front for a stride in the late going but couldn't contain GRAT on the wire. PLEASANT EMILY bobbed at the start, was never far back, followed the leaders five wide, was inside the top two in the upper stretch, loomed menacingly between foes but wasn't good enough. HOLD A MOONBEAM went up early to press front-running SHEER LUCK three or four wide, was on about even terms for the lead in the final furlong but came up empty. SHEER LUCK gained the lead early, accomplished pedestrian fractions while managing a narrow advantage, held on well into the final furlong and weakened. RELAXED maneuvered in early to track the pace four wide, continued close up into the final furlong and weakened. DYNAVILLE settled in behind horses early, remained within easy striking distance near the inside into the final furlong and failed to fire. HALO SUN, four or five wide, weakened on the far turn. ANEGADA, reserved inside early, swung out entering the stretch but never menaced. MISS GOOSEBUMPS was outrun. SIBERIAN AMUR, forwardly placed four or five wide the opening half, fell back soon after when the saddle slipped. The rider removed his feet from the irons and SIBERIAN AMUR was pulled up on the far turn and collected by the outrider in the upper stretch.
