MARIA'S MOON sped clear to dictate terms and gamely led throughout. TURN TO BERNSTEIN stumbled at the start and was unhurried into stride, worked her way forward from between horses, weaved through traffic through the drive and was just up to earn the place. IT'S TIFFIN TIME hopped at the start, settled in hand four wide, ranged up to make a mild bid entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. BROADWAY BERTIE angled in to save ground, got through to make a bold bid leaving the second turn but failed to sustain the drive. HYPER HANNAH was allowed to settle, closed the gap five wide but weakened during the drive. NOLIN LAKE saved ground to little avail. POET'S EYE was forwardly placed three wide to the stretch and faded. MARKET AT MIDDAY chased the pace off of the inside, but came up empty from between horses entering the lane and faded fast. PALIN was through early. RADIO FOX was outrun.
