READY'S ROCKET battled RED RALLY from the start, finally shook off that one in midstretch to open a clear lead with a furlong to go then lasted late. RED RALLY vied for the lead outside the winner, battled on even terms into the stretch, dropped back a bit with a furlong to go then came again late to miss. BE ME forwardly placed three wide, moved closer on the turn, lost a bit of ground in midstretch then lacked the needed closing bid. ENVISIONING within striking distance off the inside, angled out four wide leaving the turn and was gaining late. HEADSTART outrun early, angled five wide late on the turn and closed well in the final furlong. FOUR WEALTH was no threat. STAN THE TAP MAN tired.
