HEADACHE stalked the pace three wide, took over nearing the five-sixteenths pole, quickly opened clear and widened to score as the rider pleased. NORTHERN GIANT was allowed to settle, came four wide to make his bid, was no match for the winner but stayed on well to earn the place. STAY PUT was unhurried into stride, circled five wide to make a late rally but lacked the needed late response. WEALTH TO ME advanced between rivals to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. JARDIM (BRZ) prompted the pace along the inside for six furlongs and dropped out. DA DA DA DUM set the pressured pace two wide, was headed near the five-sixteenths pole and gave way readily. PLEASANT PRINCE saved ground to no avail.
