Footnotes

HURRICANE BERTIE, never far back, rallied three wide leaving the turn, caught front-running BOURBON BELLE nearing the final furlong and drew clear under urging. BOURBON BELLE dueled for the lead from the start while outside MARSHEWLEW, shook off that one, moved clear nearing the stretch but couldn't handle the winner in the final furlong. STONEY JODY broke sharply, quickly fell back, saved ground into the stretch, angled five wide at the eighth pole but could gain only slightly. CHITKA followed the leaders in a striking position four wide, remained prominent into the final furlong and failed to respond. MARSHEWLEW contested the pace early, then gave way badly from the effort.
