GOLDEN TEMPER, reserved off the dueling leaders three abreast from early on, advanced steadily from that position approaching the stretch, took over nearing the eighth pole and was under intermittent urging to win going away. BOOM TOWN GIRL moved inside early, raced four wide on the backstretch, was steadied suddenly between rivals approaching the three-eighths pole, recovered, came out from between horses entering the stretch, loomed four or five wide outside the winner through the drive but couldn't threaten while earning the place. HONEY HILL LIL broke sharply and went up to vie for the lead early while outside GOLDEN ILLUSION, took over from that one entering the backstretch, drew clear on the second turn but weakened in the drive. SWEEPING STORY saved ground from the start, came out a bit for the drive but couldn't offer a serious response. ISLE BE LOVING YOU, outrun for six furlongs, reached contention five wide in the upper stretch but lacked a further response. BLARIN SPEED wasn't a factor. DONTFIGHTHEDEVIL followed the leaders in a striking position five wide on the second turn but weakened in the drive. GOLDEN ILLUSION gained a slight edge inside early, dueled with HONEY HILL LIL into the backstretch, gave way and was pulled up bleeding from the nostrils.
