MAY GATOR gained the lead early, worked her way inside, controlled the pace through modest fractions and remained clear under pressure. INTRODUCER, within easy striking distance and racing along the inside throughout, couldn't offer the needed response as second best. DAISYAGO, never far back, tracked the winner four wide most of the way and also failed to offer a closing account. FLYING MARLIN, unhurried early, raced between foes, raced four or five wide from the backstretch on, edged closer into the upper stretch but failed to gain in the final furlong. JESTER settled inside, moved between rivals three or four wide approaching the stretch but was empty when straightened for the drive. HIGH POTENTIAL failed to rally and was six wide in the stretch. CROOKED WOOD chased the winner three or four wide until the final quarter and weakened thereafter. TRACI'S WILD was finished approaching the stretch.
