SAFE TRIP pulled to the fore three deep, opened clear leaving the turn and held sway. KAJIWARA stalked the pace off of the inside, came three wide to make a bold bid but failed to gain on the winner. GOOD LORD broke in the air, made a steady advance circling five wide and was along for the show. DANCING ROMAN was allowed to settle, advanced between horses through the turn, offered a mild bid but lacked the needed late response. MR. BRISTOL was slow into stride, came four wide to make a belated gain but was left with too much to do. SPOOKY'S READY broke a step slow, was hustled along on the inside but came up empty in the final furlong and faded. FIST OF RAGE showed little. NINEWAYHIT vied for the lead along the inside to the stretch and stopped.
