RAVEN'S HONOR opened clear to dictate terms, increased the advantage entering the stretch and held safely. MR. CHOW tracked the pace three wide, failed to make headway on the winner but dug in to earn the place. BEL AIR BULLET pulled to contention along the inside, got through but lacked the needed late response. PRINCE OF SPAIN settled saving ground under a snug hold, angled out entering the stretch but failed to improve position. CITY CONNECT broke slow, dropped well back, circled six wide and finished with a belated gain. ENGLISH POUND broke slow, tucked in to save ground but lacked a response when called upon. SIEGFRIED LINE was in tight between horses early, was shuffled back and shifted out to be clear, made a middle move four wide to offer a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. KRUTHEN stumbled badly at the start and unseated his jockey. The Stewards conducted an inquiry into the start but following the review made no change to the order of finish.
