**Footnotes**

EARTH SHAKER went up early to force the pace, edged inward, gained the advantage just prior to going a quarter, moved clear on the turn, then was kept to her task in the drive. SPINNERET, never far back while following the leaders four or five wide, loomed a strong threat outside the winner for the final furlong and wasn't good enough. CALL ME MEG, well placed near the inside early, moved up between foes approaching the stretch, angled five wide for the drive but lacked a final response. MYTHICAL BROWNIE, outrun for a half while near the inside, came out six or seven wide for the drive, became a threat leaving the furlong grounds and failed to offer a further account. NANNIE'S SWORD, well placed three or four wide into the stretch, flattened out. DANCE DANCE, in behind rivals three wide into the stretch, worked her way out eight wide at the furlong grounds but lacked a rally. SLEWTHEBOAT, outrun into the stretch while inside, improved position but couldn't threaten. DECADENT LADY, in front inside after the start, lost the edge to the winner just before going a quarter, continued forwardly inside for five furlongs and gradually weakened. BEE LINE GENIUS, in contention five wide for a half, faded thereafter.
