Footnotes

CRIMSON SISTER, outsprinted early and racing three wide throughout, rallied entering the stretch, caught the leaders a sixteenth out and drove clear late. SAVANNAH HANNA broke in the air to trail briefly, angled inside, came out eight wide for the drive and finished with good courage. SOUTHERN BROAD, outrun for a half while near the inside, angled out four or five wide for the stretch run and offered a mild gain. DIXIE TACTICS broke through the gate prior to the start and was alertly captured by the assistant starter. She was reloaded. During the running DIXIE TACTICS raced in a striking position four wide to the lane, angled out father for the drive but flattened out late. CAUY chased front-running GLITTER MUSIC four or five wide, reached the front in the upper stretch but faltered soon after. GLITTER MUSIC drifted out early while gaining a clear lead, made the pace well off the inside, showed the way into the stretch while continuing off the inside and faltered. GLITTER BOND, well placed four or five wide to the stretch, faded in the drive.
