**Footnotes**

KYLERS MIDGE, confidently ridden from the outset, gained a slim lead, raced very near the inner railing, dueled with BOONE'S DIAMOND, then responded to mild urging in the drive to prevail. BOONE'S DIAMOND pressed the winner from early on, raced three or four wide and wasn't good enough in a solid try. PERKY PEAKS, outrun inside to the stretch, angled three or four wide for the drive and was closing late. BLUE MOON RISING stalked the battling leaders four wide into the stretch and flattened out. SAVANNAH HANNA followed the leaders five wide to the stretch and came up empty. NASTY AND CRAFTY raced near the inside and faded in the drive. GENTEEL was outrun.
