Footnotes

ALPHABET MAGIC sprinted clear and relaxed setting a soft pace, repulsed a bid by the runner up on the second turn, drew clear in midstretch and lasted late. DUBIOUS MISS closest to the pace off the inside, challenged the winner on the second turn, could not quite keep pace with that one in midstretch but was coming again late. MAMBO IN SEATTLE forwardly placed three wide, rallied willingly late. GOLDEN YANK reserved off the inside, angled out four wide with three furlongs to go placing SIR WHIMSEY in tight, made a challenging run in that path approaching the stretch, was bumped by PROM SHOES in upper stretch then lodged a mild late bid. PROM SHOES outrun early, made a bold five wide middle move, drifted in to bump GOLDEN YANK in upper stretch and tired. SIR WHIMSEY within striking distance four wide, took up near the three furlong marker when GOLDEN YANK angled out then could not menace. BUDGE MAN outrun early four wide, angled in, raced in the two path on the second turn and was no threat. SHIFT IN POWER forwardly placed along the inside, faded.
