Footnotes

SAVIANO moved into striking distance along the inside, angled out four wide to continue the advance, wore down the leaders inside the furlong marker and edged clear. SCARIFF ISLAND settled saving ground, got through entering the stretch, poked his head in front with a furlong to run, but was unable to resist the winner. TOMMY AND BUSTER contested the pace three wide, opened clear leaving the turn, was collared between horses, weakened during the drive but had enough left to hold the show. JOLLY OL' NICK was slow into stride, got through and improved position through the stretch. RED WINE was allowed to settle, circled five wide to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. CANDY RUN was close up four wide through the second turn and retreated. YOU DA MANDATE broke a step slow, rushed up between horses, but came up empty entering the stretch and dropped out. CITIZEN JOHN showed little.
