Footnotes

BLUSHING CALLER drifted in at the start and soundly jolted RONDAL, went up to duel for the lead outside of MISS NIKNAR, gained a slim advantage, made the balance of the pace and was kept to her task while holding FLYING TIGRESS safe. The latter, outrun for a half, rallied six wide into the stretch and finished with good energy. MISS NIKNAR contested the pace inside the winner from early on, battled with BLUSHING CALLER into the final furlong and weakened only slightly. WADLEIGH ONE broke alertly, settled within easy striking distance, loomed five wide through the final furlong but came up empty. A. J. TOP, bumped at the start, recovered to race within striking distance, raced four wide into the final furlong and lacked a late response. MISS TESSIE drifted in at the start and bumped A.J. TOP, made a bid four wide nearing the final furlong but came up empty late. MT. MOMPERS, bumped at the start and forced in, was steadied briefly and outrun until the stretch, then offered a mild gain. A. J. TOP, bumped at the start, made a run five wide around the turn but flattened out when straightened for the drive. RIGHT ON COURSE tired early. MAR GEE was finished upon going a half. RONDAL, bumped soundly at the start and forced in, was outrun.
