**Footnotes**

DREAM TRIPPER gained the lead early, quickly angled inward, drew off on the backstretch to a command advantage through rapid fractions, managed a clear margin into the stretch and held sway under pressure. KENDALL POINT, in closest attendance to DREAM TRIPPER from early on, finished willingly inside that one to earn second. SILVER ON SILVER stalked the winner four wide throughout, loomed a solid threat for the last eighth but lacked a final response. AIR ROCKET, reserved inside early, crept closer on the second turn while continuing inside, angled four wide for the drive and lacked a late bid. WILD DREAM, in contention while four or five wide, came out farther on the course for the drive and offered a minor gain. CLASSIC CHUNT, within striking distance five wide for six furlongs, lacked a late response. MIGHTY NICE BET failed to threaten despite reducing the deficit. LAMERIE (IRE) failed to reach contention. ANSKY never was close. NEWSPEAK broke in a tangle, was outrun, took a bad step nearing the final furlong and was pulled up lame.
