Footnotes

AT THE KNEES, within striking distance and five wide much of the way, moved to challenge in the upper stretch, lugged in brushing JUST AS WELL at the furlong grounds and edged clear under left-handed urging. JUST AS WELL stumbled at the start, settled four wide, rallied nearing the stretch, reached the front between calls in the upper stretch, then couldn't handle the winner late and was brushed by AT THE KNEES in the late going. CODASCO worked his way to the rail on the backstretch, continued inside but couldn't produce the needed late gain. AIR CORREDOR, outrun early, made mild run four or five wide into the upper stretch and failed to continue. BOND STREET, outrun for six furlongs, came out six or seven wide for the drive and improved position. COMMANDER'S SHOES went up to gain the advantage inside early, was clear for a half, was joined on the turn from the outside by CAPTAIN CRYPTO, held on well until the upper stretch and tired. EMISSARY, within easy striking distance while between horses four wide to the stretch, weakened thereafter. CAPTAIN CRYPTO dueled with COMMANDER'S SHOES while outside that one for six furlongs and tired.
