Footnotes

BLOCK stalked the pace from early on while in hand four wide, inched closer on the far turn, swept to the front in the upper stretch, kicked clear and was kept to her task. PRINCESS WESTLY, bumped at the break by PRETTY SIMPLE and forced out on NORMANDY QUEEN, was unhurried three wide, followed the winner five wide into the lane and was clearly second best. MISS ABITA angled in early while gaining the lead, was joined from the outside by ETCHED IN GOLD, battled with that one to the stretch and weakened. LADY LAPUMA, within striking distance and five wide, came a bit wider for the stretch run and improved position while unable to menace. ETCHED IN GOLD went up to force the issue early, battled with MISS ABITA while outside that one, gained a slim lead, raced up close to the lane and weakened. PILAF drifted in on ROYAL DIVA at the start, was outrun to the stretch and passed tired foes. ROYAL DIVA, bumped from both sides at the start and steadied in tight quarters, settled three wide and failed to rally. PRETTY SIMPLE came out bumping PRINCESS WESTLY at the start and tired on the far turn. NORMANDY QUEEN, bumped at the start by PRINCESS WESTLY and forced out into ROYAL DIVA, was steadied and squeezed a bit, raced forwardly for nearly six furlongs and tired.
