FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$5,000 at time of entry. \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 additional to start with \$100,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Three year olds, 118 lbs. Older, 124 lbs.

Non-winners of a Grade I or II stakes in 2009 allowed 2 lbs.; \$60,000 twice in 2008-2009, 4 lbs.; three races other than maiden or claiming since October 25, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. Trophy to winning owner.

DUBAI MAJESTY dueled for the lead along the inside, battled through a prolonged drive, dug in with renewed vigor late and gamely edged clear. LADY CHACE dueled for the lead from the outside, drifted out late under left handed urging and grudgingly gave way. KEEP THE PEACE tracked the pace three deep, came four wide to make her bid, was gaining steadily but was carried out late and lost her best chance. TEMPLE STREET angled in at once to save ground, made a late rally three wide and improved position through the lane. TIZ TO DREAM dropped well back early, swung five wide to make her bid but was left with too much to do. NADESHIKO settled saving ground, got through to make a mild gain but failed to threaten. TAR HEEL MOM chased the pace four wide to the stretch and tired. The jockey of KEEP THE PEACE lodged an objection against LADY CHACE for drifting out and taking her path inside the sixteenth marker forcing that one to alter course, following the Stewards review LADY CHACE was disqualified from second and placed third.
