Footnotes

ATTRACTIVE RIDE settled saving ground, angled out leaving the turn to make his bid, reeled in the leaders nearing the furlong marker and steadily edged clear. MAN O' WONDER settled in the second flight, moved with the winner through the turn, angled out entering the lane and kept on fairly well to earn the place. AXEL SWAGGER hopped at the start to get away slowly, dropped well back, closed some ground through the turn along the inside, shifted out with a furlong to run and continued on willingly from between rivals to gain the show spot. PISO MOJADO vied for the lead three deep, forged a narrow lead leaving the turn, disputed the issue to the final furlong and gave way. CHAPEL BY THE SEA chased the pace four wide, made a middle move to engage the leaders with a quarter to run, but weakened during the drive and faded. MY BOY JO rushed up along the inside to set the pressured pace, but came up empty after a half and retreated. AQUINAS contested the pace from between horses for five furlongs and tired. SILVER BAYER was through early.
