Footnotes

RIGHTOUS PARTY rushed to the lead, angled in and disputed the pace off of the inside, opened clear before going a quarter and remained unchallenged. BOOSTER ROCKET chased the winner to no avail, but continued on willingly to clearly prove second best. JAVA FOR TWO was away alertly, was caught in tight and veered in bumping MATAMOROS, leveled back into stride quickly, got through and kept on well to earn the show. SONG AHEAD was close up four wide, offered a mild bid entering the stretch but went evenly through the drive. BEST FIVE was bumped and checked near the eleven-sixteenths pole, advanced between horses, came three wide and improved position through the lane. PONTCHARTRAIN was pinched back between horses when JAVA FOR TWO came in, settled off of the inside, angled out and finished with a late gain. PHILLY R settled saving ground, checked and was shuffled back early, dropped well back, finished with a late rally but was left with too much to do. FLEET DECISION was allowed to settle five wide, but came up empty leaving the turn and faded. RUN THE FIGURES failed to respond. PRAYEROFWARRIOR was bumped and steadied early, settled saving ground but showed little thereafter. MATAMOROS was bumped and steadied when JAVA FOR TWO came in, made a middle move between horses to close the gap but was through after a half. HUGH THE MAN broke slow and was outrun. The jockeys of BEST FIVE and JAVA FOR TWO lodged an objection against RIGHTOUS PARTY alleging interference near the eleven-sixteenths pole, following the Stewards review RIGHTOUS PARTY was disqualified from first and placed eleventh.
