UNDERMINE, unhurried early, advanced off the inside on the second turn, challenged the leader in upper stretch and drew off under mild encouragement. PLENTY OF BRASS, within striking distance inside, made a three wide bid with a quarter mile to go, led soon after but was no match for the winner in the drive. IN DUE TIME, closest to the pace off the inside, challenged on the second turn but gave way in the drive. HONEST REPLY, outrun early, made a mild gain on the second turn but had no late bid. TOMISUE'S GOLD, forwardly placed three wide, raced three wide on the second turn and tired. PRADO'S PRIDE, four wide on the first turn when within striking distance, was through after a half. SECOND DEGREE, unhurried early, raced along the inside on the backstretch and faded in the final three furlongs. COME ON LOUISE steadied entering the first turn when in tight, raced in traffic to the backstretch then was outrun. CHOCOLATE CRUNCH set the pace, stayed well to the stretch and faded.
