Footnotes

PEACE RIVER LADY, rated in behind horses early, eased out three or four wide on the backstretch, moved steadily to wrest command approaching the stretch, then widened through the drive under solid hand urging. PURE GLITTER moved up early to press front-running FUSE IT, took over on the backstretch, lost the advantage to the winner approaching the stretch and continued on as second best. LOVE TALKIN, within easy striking distance and racing near the inside throughout, made a mild run into the final furlong but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. YES HONEY, rated four wide on the backstretch, moved between foes on the far turn and into the stretch, then failed to seriously menace while improving position. SUNSET SKIES, taken in hand early and five wide, moved to the rail on the backstretch, made a mild run along the inside into the upper stretch but lacked a late response. FUSE IT gained the lead early, moved inside, surrendered the advantage to PURE GLITTER from the outside before going a half, held on well until the stretch and tired. LOOKS THAT KILL knocked the doors opening on the start gate prior to the break but was in the hands of the assistant starter. The doors were closed and during the running, LOOKS THA KILL raced in a striking position four or five wide for five furlongs and weakened thereafter. RUNNING PAM, inside while outrun from the outset, came out five wide for the drive but failed to rally. MYSTERY AT SEA, in contention four or five wide for five furlongs, came out wider approaching the stretch and faded.
