Footnotes

WRZESZCZ vied for the lead early while between foes, gained a narrow advantage, was engaged by GO LIONEL GO entering the stretch, then gamely bested that one under solid left-handed encouragement. GO LIONEL GO, never far back, moved boldly four wide nearing the final quarter, battled with the winner while outside that one the remainder and wasn't good enough. WILDLY, never far back, raced in behind the leaders, angled to the rail for the drive but failed to gain in the final furlong. GLITTERGEM, within striking distance always, raced five or six wide into the final furlong and was empty. TROPICAL STORM, sluggish to begin, was hustled along to gain a position inside but was empty in the drive. RANDLORD settled in behind horses early, came out six or seven wide for the stretch run but never menaced. FOOT TRICK, sluggish to start, rushed up along the inside to contest the pace, gained a slight edge but was done approaching the stretch. SUPER BE BUSTER was outrun.
