KODIAK KOWBOY raced in behind rivals three wide from early on, came a bit wider for the drive, reached the front at the furlong pole and drove clear. YONEGWA moved to the fore inside early, was engaged in the upper stretch and held on gamely to save the place. GERONI chased front-running YONEGWA three or four wide, gained even terms for the lead in the last eighth but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. DEPUTY DANCE, within striking distance and four wide much of the way, lacked a closing response. EATON'S GIFT, in contention but always five or six wide, had no rally. OLD MAN BUCK broke in front, quickly dropped back and never threatened. PINERLINE failed to menace. PULASKI COUNTY drifted out while breaking sluggishly and never was prominent. SEASIDE STORM, slow to start, was outrun.
