STRONG DREAM vied for the lead while off the inside after breaking alertly, edged clear late under pressure. LEADING CANDIDATE forwardly placed four wide, lacked a late bid but was clearly second best. CARSON'S VENTURE alternated for the lead along the inside and tired late. LIGHTING RAY outrun to the stretch, never menaced. SLEW AND THE CITY within striking distance, steadied entering the turn then tired. FLY LUC AN EAGLE behind the leaders, moved to the inside with three furlongs to go and faded. ROSES IN EXCESS steadied four wide entering the turn then was no factor. WITTY KITTY steadied along the inside near the three furlong marker then could not menace.
