FIVE STAR DAVID sprinted clear, set the pace near the rail, angled out a bit for the drive and proved best while fully extended. COFFEE BOY behind the leaders, saved ground late on the turn, angled out a bit for the drive, moved back towards the rail in midstretch and was gaining late inside rivals. GRAND TRAVERSE pressed the pace off the inside, made a run at the winner late on the turn, dropped back a bit into the stretch then finished willingly. CANOOK within striking distance, angled out for the drive and closed well. MURJAN forwardly placed from the start, angled out for the drive but lacked a late response. MUHAASEB was outrun five wide.
